the assembly.

following the annual meeting

The Board of Bomb Twp without a regular meeting decide to do the same, and the Clerk is instructed to proceed, and to have new voting booths made.

2. At this meeting a discussion is held about repairs to the Hall. After inspection it is found a new roof is needed. The Board decides to proceed with repairs, and Sityna, and DeYoung are appointed as committee with due responsibility to see to the work.
