

Annual Township meeting held
March 29, 1980

1. The meeting is called to order at 1:00 O'clock P.M. by the Twp. Supervisor Paul Doctor.
2. The notice of the annual meeting was read by the clerk, and the minutes of the last annual meeting of March 31, 1979 were read for information.
3. The number of citizens present at the meeting was 19.
4. The receipts and expenditures for the 1979-80 fiscal year, were read by the clerk, and questions answered.
The budget for the year 1980-81 as proposed by the Twp. Board, in the amount of \$65,783.00, is read by the clerk, and approved by the Assembly.
5. Due to the fact that all the property assessed for taxation in Banks Twp. will be reassessed this year 1980, as required by law, Mr. Iron Parsons certified assessor, who has been hired by the Twp. Board, spent some time explaining to the assembly how the program will be implemented.
6. The clerk reported that the Fire Dept fund

because of the purchase of a New Fire Truck
was indebted to the General Fund in the amount
of \$9,073.46. Since these funds are all tax supported
there is a motion from the floor ^{and supported} to cancel this debt.
This was not approved.

7. Next there is a motion from the floor and a supporter
that we ~~should~~ ask the voters for approval
of $\frac{1}{2}$ mill for the Fire Fund ^{But} due to the fact that a
^{multiplier} ~~a factor~~ of ~~7.7339~~ ^{7.2039} will be applied to the 1980
assessed valuation of Bank Twp. This will
bring in some ^{36.76} 30,000 more tax money, in the general fund.
This motion is not adopted by the assembly.

8. Next a motion to ask the voters to approve
 $\frac{1}{4}$ mill for the Fire Fund for 1980 is adopted by the
assembly. The Twp. Board is instructed to bring
this to the Reg. voters of Bank Twp. for approval.

9. Members of the Lions International ^{Club} of Ells
present the Twp. for use at the community hall a
96 cup Coffee Urn. The assembly votes to give
them a word of thanks for this gift.
